<sup>2</sup> Reported figures are the budget **awarded** to recipients on basis of the Grant Agreement (GA) signed with the project consortia. The GA allows budget flexibility between cost categories both within and between partners, which is monitored at the time of the payments. In practice, the difference in actually paid amounts vs initially awarded ones is low at the entity level, and at the country level such differences are minimal. Also, an action needs to be closed from the administrative point of view to extract information on final budget distribution. Considering the low number of closed actions, it is still too early in the programme implementation cycle for such figures to be considered in lieu of the awarded amounts.
